Living with Animals in WVA: Living with Coyotes

Coyotes live in both rural and urban areas throughout Arizona, Westbrook Village is no exception. Below are some tips for living with coyotes:

Don't leave your pets unattended

NEVER FEED COYOTES

Feeding coyotes attracts them back to the area, reduces their natural fear of humans and is against the law (the "No Feeding Wildlife Law" makes feeding coyotes illegal in Maricopa County).

Keep shrubs & branches trimmed to eliminate potential hiding places or shade for coyotes.

Dog Issues

Please be a courteous and a responsible pet owner.

Maricopa County's leash law prohibits you from allowing your dog to run at large outside your property at any time. Your dog must be confined to your home or property, whether inside the home or within an enclosed yard. When you take your dog outside of its confined area, it must be restrained on a leash that is no longer than 6 feet in length. The owner or person having custody of said dog shall be responsible for removal of any animal solid waste from community areas. Failure to do so can result in a \$250 fine.
