Editor's Message



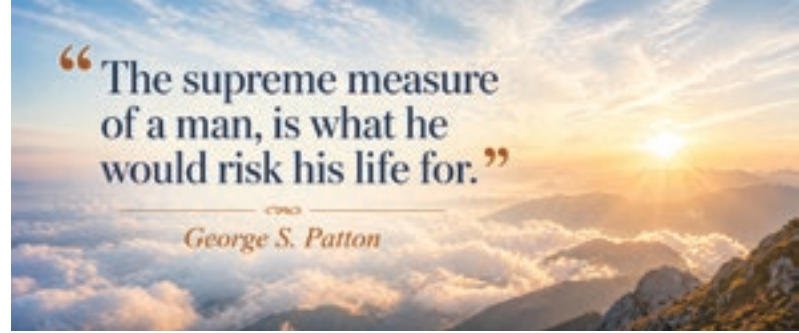

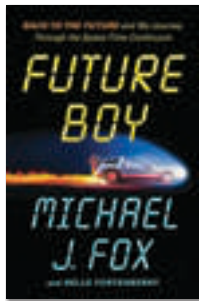

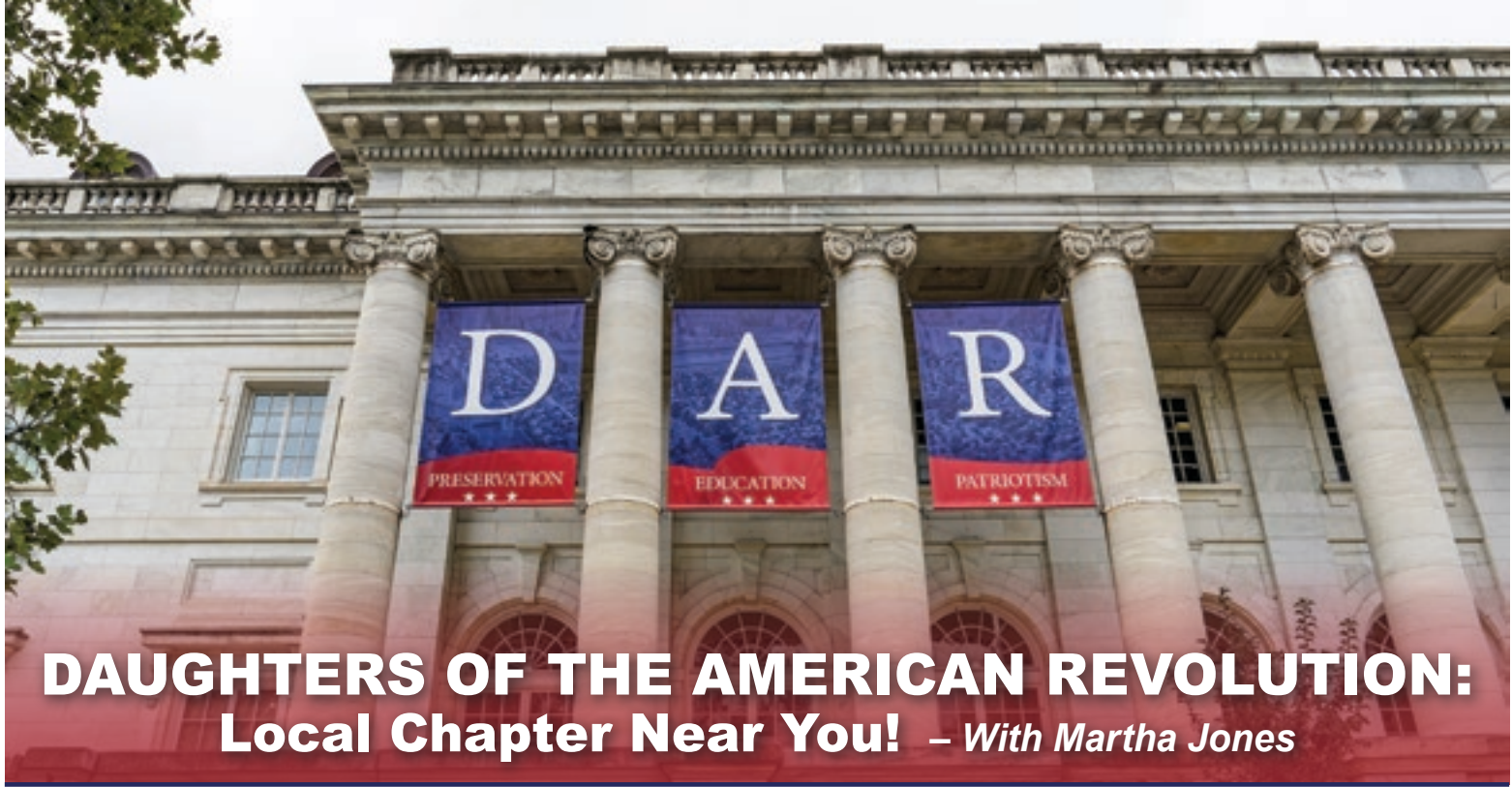

DAUGHTERS OF THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION: Local Chapter Near You! – With Martha Jones

In this 250th year since our nation officially rose to freedom, it is fitting to feature an organization that has long honored the profound legacies our ancestors bequeathed us during the American Revolution. Daughters of the American Revolution was founded in 1890, and the DAR website states that, “since the Society’s founding, more than one million women have found purpose and passion in DAR membership.”

Many years ago, WV resident, Martha Jones, went through her genealogy and discovered ancestors who had served during the Revolution. After becoming an active DAR member, Martha volunteered as a meeting secretary. She soon found herself organizing a new chapter, and by 2006, she had been elected State Regent for Arizona. She subsequently served as VP General in Arizona from 2008 to 2011. “I have always been impressed how DAR maintains its commitment to *historic preservation, education, and patriotism*,” explained Martha from her home in Westbrook Village. She added, “It is no longer your grandma’s DAR with white gloves at every meeting. Official attire is reserved for official events.”

The DAR chapters in Arizona are devoted to outreaches such as scholarships, veterans-related charitable efforts, and assisting with Honor Flights. Martha assisted in a very special Honor Flight where all the passengers consisted of DAR member female veterans, and the flight crew was made up of all women, too! She explains, “We gave them a very special send-off and welcome upon their return!”

Martha is passionate about how special it is for women to discover their families’ roots in the American Revolution, and the stories that make up their legacy. Her neighbor, Kari Haska, received Martha’s DAR magazine by mistake some time ago, and Kari looked at the error as a good excuse to get involved at her local chapter.

INSPIRATIONAL CORNER: Road to Forgiving Ourselves

*“Be kind to one another, tenderhearted,
forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.”*

– Ephesians 4:32 [even ourselves, since He did!]



Some of life's hurts did not come from others. Some hurts came from things we did or did not do, things we said or did not say. As we look back at the landscape of our life, we may still feel them deeply. How do we break free, let go?

Here is a simple little story that might help:

“The Pebble in the Shoe”

*There once was a young traveler named Eli.
He had a kind heart, but he'd made mistakes.*

Big ones. Hurtful ones.

So instead of heading home, he kept walking.

And walking.

*Through towns, across rivers, under stars—
trying to escape the weight of what he'd done.*

But no matter how far he went, his steps felt heavy.

His foot ached more each day.

One evening, as the sun dipped low, an old woman saw him limping.

She called out, “Come sit, traveler. Let me look at that foot.”

She gently removed his boot... and found a small pebble inside.

“You’ve walked all this way with this?” she asked.

He looked away. “I thought I deserved the pain.”

She held the pebble in her hand and said,

“This didn’t punish you. It only slowed your healing.”

Then she looked him in the eye and said softly,

“You have carried your guilt long enough.

Now... let yourself walk free.”

Eli cried.

Not because it hurt...

But because he had forgotten he was allowed to feel relief.

Allowed to be forgiven. Even by himself.

*And the next morning, for the first time in a long time...
his steps were light.*

This little story reminds us that many of us carry “pebbles in our shoe.” We have suffered. We have thought that if we suffer enough, we can somehow forgive ourselves.

But we will never heal by punishing ourselves. What we can acknowledge is that we have changed since that/those mistakes were made. Our hearts have changed as well. We learned from those mistakes—in spades. Don't carry it forever.

WVA Treasurer's Report

For the Month Ending February 28, 2026

"The following figures are subject to audit. However, they fairly represent the approximate financial condition of the Association at month end."

GENERAL OPERATING FUND

(Funds designated for day-to-day operations.)

The General Operating Fund exists to support the day-to-day operations of the Westbrook Village Association. As of February, 2026, this fund holds a cash balance of \$3,746,579.37. This total includes the homeowner assessments collected for the year 2026, as well as certificates of deposit, which together provide the Association with a strong financial foundation for its ongoing operational needs.

For the 2026 fiscal year, the Association anticipates total revenue of \$3,553,638.00, of which \$3,202,290.00 is expected to come from member assessments. This underscores the importance of member contributions in sustaining the activities of the Association. During February the Association received total revenue of \$331,016.61, while total operating expenses for the same period amounted to \$257,360.18. Notably, expenses in February were under budget by \$34,000, reflecting careful management and a conscientious approach to spending by the Management and staff.

REPLACEMENT RESERVE FUND

(Funds earmarked for major repairs, equipment replacement, and capital improvements)

The Replacement Reserve Fund is designed to finance major repairs, equipment replacements, and capital improvements throughout Westbrook Village. As of February 28, 2026, the Reserve Fund Balance stands at \$4,899,566.71.

This fund is supported by proceeds from home sales and preservation fees collected during those transactions. In February there were 20 home resales within the community, with preservation fees waived for 9 of these transactions.

For fiscal year 2026, the Association has budgeted \$1,577,650.00 in expenditures from the Replacement Reserve Fund. So far, \$101,862.29 of this budget has been used. For the month of February \$6,105 was spent for perimeter wall repairs, door opener repairs and the replacement of a spa heater.

The remaining budgeted funds are allocated for upcoming projects such as a possible gym facility at the Lakes, which includes the installation of a fire sprinkler system. Additional planned initiatives include a turf reduction project in Phase I, as well as ongoing maintenance projects throughout Westbrook Village.

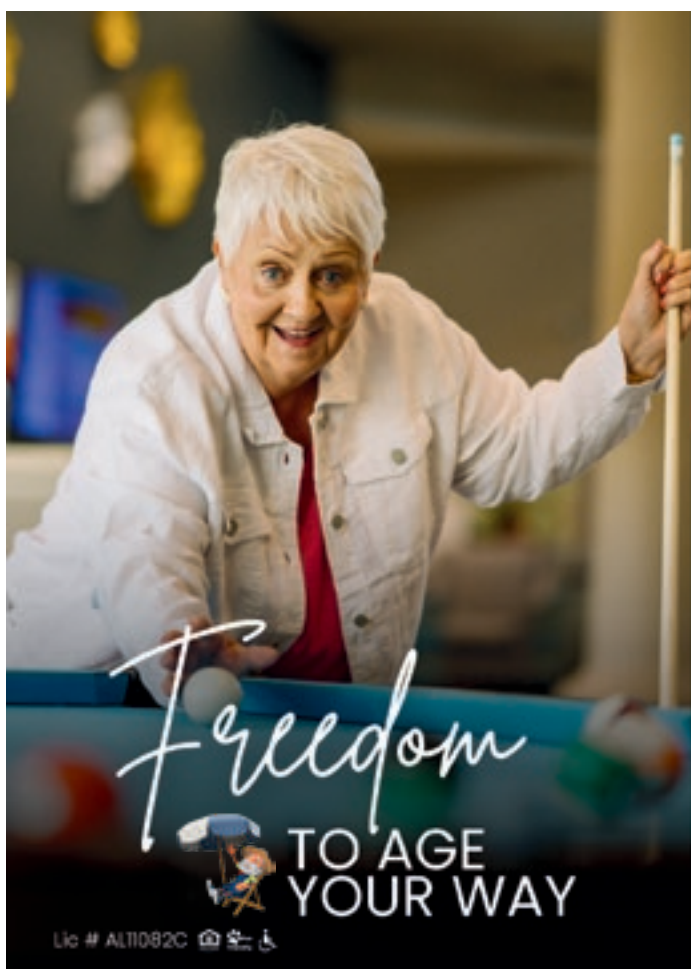
In its 22nd year, the Heritage Cup has become a Westbrook Village tradition!

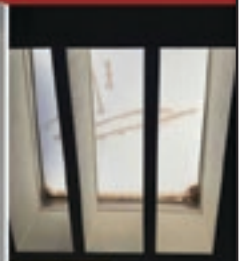

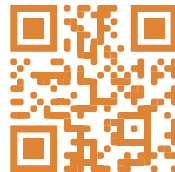

VACATION WATCH - WHAT and WHY - With Ann Beranis



One of the ways Westbrook Posse protects and serves the community is by conducting vacation watches for those who leave their homes for 7 days or more. This is not an automatic service, but rather involves filling out a Vacation Watch form with contact information, the name

of a "keyholder," the date you are leaving and returning, and general information--such as whether gates are locked or a security system is installed.

During a Posse Vacation Watch period, a Posse Deputy will walk around the property, check windows and doors, look for irrigation leaks and storm damage, notify the identified keyholder about packages left at the door, and remove accumulated solicitor flyers or newspapers, a flag that would indicate homeowner's absence. If the Posse Deputy observes

someone on or in the property, and the Posse office has not been notified that someone was scheduled to be there, the homeowner will be contacted to verify permission.

Why is this service important? Although the Peoria Police Dept. maintains that Westbrook Village is one of the lowest crime areas in the City of Peoria, *crimes of opportunity* do occur here. Open garage doors and unlocked cars are often the reason, but we do find when checking a Vacation Watch home for the first time, residents have accidentally left home and garage doors unlocked. We often find irrigation leaks on property, and storm damage during monsoon season.

The Westbrook Posse wants homes and neighborhoods to be safe and secure while residents are away and also for permanent residents who remain in the community. We strongly encourage homeowners to take advantage of our house check service and register.
